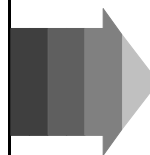

From the Lay Director

Dear friends in Christ,

As the new year begins, we are entering into new beginnings, new challenges, and new hopes. I have to tell you, becoming the new Lay Director is challenging, yet full of exciting beginnings and hopes. Before I talk about those things that are exciting, I thought I'd introduce myself and give you a sense of who I am, where I've been, that sort of thing.

My name is Kevin Ayer. I attended Ohio Men's Via de Cristo Number 24 in the fall of 1991 where I sat at the table of Mark. I worship at Abiding Christ Lutheran Church in Fairborn, Ohio with my beautiful bride of 21 years, Lynn, and we have two beautiful children Kyleen who is 17 and Kyle who is 14. Lynn and I have served on several teams here in Ohio from 1991 through 1994, and continue to do so since moving back into the area in 2000. I am privileged to be your new Lay Director for the Ohio Via de Cristo movement.

In 1994, the Air Force moved us to Virginia where we met many wonderful Cursillistas in the Rainbow Via de Cristo. Lynn and I were instrumental in getting Via de Cristo revitalized in the Woodbridge, VA area. While in Virginia, we had the honor of helping spin off the Western Maryland movement out of the Virginia movement. Although it was difficult to "let them go," it was marvelous to see the new movement stand on its own. It was a joy to serve on teams in Virginia during this time period.

In 1997, the Air Force moved us to Rochester, New York where I worked on my doctorate in Imaging Sciences. While on a return visit to Ohio, we attended a Clausura. At the Clausura, Doug Burrows approached me about contacting New York's secretariat to serve on New York Men's #1. What a great experience getting in on the ground floor of a new movement; a different kind of birth than Vineyard, but no less exciting. After the Air Force moved us back to Ohio in 2000, I had the privilege of returning to New York to serve as the Music Cha for New York Men's #2 in January 2001.

I've taught many adult and children's Sunday school classes in Ohio, Virginia, and New York. I have to say one of my most favorite teaching experiences was with the Bethlehem Lutheran Church High School Sunday School class in New York. The topic was Revelation. I challenged them... they challenged me... We started with 10 young adults. By the end of the six-month study, we had over 30! It was a great experience I will treasure forever.

Another passion I have is music. I love all sorts of music... everything from Hillsong Ministries to Echelon, Carmen to Lost & Found. I believe music is the universal language that joins heads, hearts, and hands together to serve our Risen Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

I'd like to close this message with a few words from one of my favorite songs, words that capture the essence of my philosophy. It goes like this: "We are one in the Spirit. We are one in the Lord." The song goes on to tell us how we are to live our lives, working with each other side by side, guarding each one's dignity and pride, walking hand in hand to tell everyone that God is in our land! 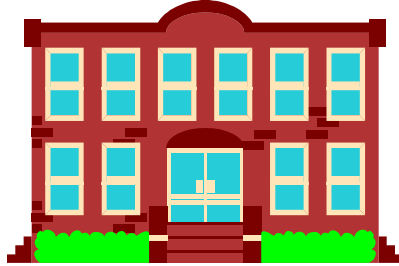
De Colores Everyone,

Cursillo is a tested and valid renewal movement which began in the Roman Catholic Church and is now active in many Protestant denominations. The Lutheran expression of this movement is called Via de Cristo (*Way of Christ*). It is designed for baptized Christians over the age of 18 who wish to strengthen and nurture their commitment to Christ. Via de Cristo does not provide solutions to serious personal problems, nor does it diminish the importance of the institutional church. No one is expected to respond to the Via de Cristo experience in any specific "approved" manner.

Via de Cristo weekends begin at 7:00 PM Thursdays and end about 8:00 PM Sundays, and consist of a sequence of inter-dependent events which require that each pilgrim be present for the entire weekend. Couples are encouraged to complete applications at the same time, and also encouraged but not required to attend the same set of weekends. There is no set charge to attend a weekend, but pilgrims will be given the opportunity to contribute. Via de Cristo receives no direct financial support from the Lutheran Church.

You will be informed when your application has been received and be given further information at that time. Meanwhile, please direct any questions to your sponsor(s). Please answer all questions fully so that we can provide a meaningful and pleasant experience. Please PRINT OR TYPE.

Before you approach your pilgrim: (**note** maximum of one pilgrim per table per church)

1. The Via de Cristo movement is a Christian program of renewal for baptized believers in Christ. The Weekend is an emotional and deeply spiritual experience that is not suited for everyone. Your pilgrims should be physically and emotionally able to experience the Weekend completely and must have the endorsement of their pastors to attend. In the case of a married woman, it is the norm that her spouse attend first. If there are concerns in any of these areas, please send a letter of explanation to the Secretariat from you and the pastor or call Spiritual Director Douglas Fidler (330-673-5445) before you give the application to your pilgrim. Pray and consider fully before taking any action.
2. Clergy endorsement is required. Check with the endorsing clergy before approaching a prospective pilgrim to ensure endorsement will be forthcoming. Failure to do so can cause serious embarrassment, for pastors may know something, unknown to sponsor, that makes that person an unsuitable pilgrim for Via de Cristo. If the appropriate clergy decline to endorse an application for any other reason, notify a Secretariat member in your area so the problem can be addressed at the appropriate level by the Spiritual Director. Do not proceed until such an issue is resolved by the proper persons.

When you talk to your pilgrim:

3. Once you have clergy concurrence, approach the prospective pilgrim, answer any questions, explain that a free-will offering will be taken at the Weekend to defray expenses, and assist in filling out the Pilgrim Application to ensure accuracy and completeness. Ensure each application contains all required signatures, is legible and complete - especially date of birth and "First Name You Wish For Your Name Tag" entries.

After your pilgrim agrees to attend:

4. For each applicant, mail the fully completed Pilgrim Application and Sponsor Application along with your non-refundable check for \$15.00 (payable to "Lutheran Via de Cristo of Ohio" to the address on the front of this form.
5. Stay in contact with your applicant(s) and give your active support. Both applicants and sponsors will receive acknowledgment of registration and instructions for the Weekend.

Via de Cristo had roots in Spain

Lay Director Kevin Ayer has asked me to do some articles on the history of Via de Cristo of Ohio and some of the people who promoted it. Perhaps this first one should be called "Roots." Most of the information comes from a 4th *Day Manual*, published by the National Lutheran Secretariat.

Histories are long. I plan to shorten it Scripps-Howard style (Oran Gough knows).

The ministry was born as The Cursillo Movement on the island of Majorca, Spain in the 1940s. It came out of the Little Courses for Pilgrimage Leaders, instituted by the Catholic Action for Young Men. In other words, it was training for church leaders. The Cursillo Movement continues as a strong arm of the Roman Catholic Church. It spread from Spain into Latin America, where it was expanded to include women. It was brought to the United States by two Spanish airmen who were training in Texas. The first U.S. weekend was in 1957 in Mission, Texas.

Weekends spread to New York and Ohio by 1959, all held in Spanish. The first English weekend was held in 1961. The movement spread to the Episcopal Church in 1965 and in 1972, two Lutheran movements began in Florida and Iowa after pastors and laymen attended Episcopal weekends.

In 1980, with the help of ALC Bishop David Wolber, the National Lutheran Secretariat Constitution was drafted. Reflecting the ecumenism of the Lutheran movement, which allows team members from other denominations, not allowed by the Catholic Church, our name was changed from Cursillo to Via de Cristo. The movement's theological and doctrinal content is in keeping with the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America and attempts to fulfill its stated purpose.
